DIRECTOR


He's back again, directing Mitres' *Madness* at the Minack and having a ball!!


LOUISE GAUNTLETT



Tim Firth began writing when he was eighteen on an Arvon Foundation course in Yorkshire, run by Willy Russell and Danny Hiller. After studying at Cambridge for three years, his first professional commissions were Heartlands for Chichester, directed by Sam Mendes, and A Man of Letters for the Stephen Joseph Theatre, Scarborough. Tim's subsequent work included Neville's Island (1993) and The End of the Food Chain (1994), both for the Stephen Joseph Theatre. The Nottingham Playhouse production of Neville's Island went on to the Apollo Theatre in London's West End where it was nominated for an Evening Standard award and four Laurence Olivier awards.

His first feature film, *Calendar Girls* (2003), starring Helen Mirren and Julie Walters, was filmed in the summer of 2002, followed by *Blackball* (2003) and *Kinky Boots* (2005), which he co-wrote with Geoff Deane.

Recent work for the stage includes adaptations of *Calendar Girls* into both a play and a musical and, of course, *Our House*, which opened at the Cambridge Theatre in October 2002 and received three Laurence Olivier nominations including Best Musical. Tim Firth has since gone on to write another jukebox musical, *The Band*, this time with the music of Take That, which debuted in 2017.

MUSIC AND LYRICS

Along with the Specials, Madness were one of the leading bands of the ska revival of the late '70s and early '80s. As their career progressed, Madness branched away from their trademark "nutty sound" and incorporated large elements of Motown, soul, and British pop.

The origins of Madness lie in a ska group known as the Invaders. By 1978 they had changed their name to Madness, and released their debut single, "One Step Beyond", the following year. Madness quickly recorded their debut album, also titled *One Step Beyond*, which peaked at number two in Britain and stayed in the charts for well over a year. At the beginning of 1980, the band's third single, "My Girl," peaked at number three. For the next three years, the group had a virtually uninterrupted run of 13 Top Ten singles, during which time they were one of the most popular bands in Britain, rivalled only by the Jam in terms of widespread popularity.

Madness have remained popular throughout the following decades and during 2012 the band took part in high-profile performances that celebrated the best of British culture. They played from the top of Buckingham Palace at the Queen's Diamond Jubilee party and also appeared in the closing ceremony of the London Olympic Games.

Our House celebrates the music of Madness, and aims to capture their unique sound and spirit.



THEMITREPLAYERS

The Mitre Players is the dramatic society for former pupils of Trinity School, Croydon (The Trinity Mid-Whitgiftian Association). We are a very friendly and sociable society, presenting three or four productions a year in a wide variety of venues. Putting on a show not only requires people on stage, but also involves a great deal of hard work behind the scenes. We design, build and paint our own sets, find and make our own props, make many of our own costumes and use "in house" musicians whenever possible.

We would welcome any new members, so if you have any aspirations to act, sing

dance or play a musical instrument, we would like to hear from you. If you prefer to remain out of the spotlight, building scenery, lighting, painting, making costumes, making props, doing 'Front of House' or simply would like to make tea for the team, we would still like to hear from you.

Most of our rehearsals take place at the TSSSC Clubhouse in Sanderstead. The bar facilities at the clubhouse lend a social and convivial atmosphere to our rehearsals and all members are encouraged to use the facilities at Sanderstead as often as possible.
