PAUL COHEN (Aladdin) Paul has been with the Mitre Players for 3 years, appearing in two previous pantomimes and two touring shows. He also performs with various other companies and previous parts include Barnaby Tucker in Hello Dolly, Fyedka in Fiddler on the Roof and Tommy Djilas in The Music Man to name but a few.


CIARA DALY (Dwarf) This is Ciara's first time performing with the Mitre Players. She is 6 years old and attends Margaret Roper Primary School. She enjoys singing and dancing and has had great fun being a Mitre Player.

GRACE EAGERS (Dwarf) This is Grace's second pantomime. After starting rehearsals she has decided that she wants to become an actress and at the age of 8 she has already got dramatic tantrums down to a T. She has thoroughly enjoyed having the opportunity to be in this year's pantomime and can't wait for next year.

ALEX GREENSLADE (The Beast and King Rudolph) As the Mitre's resident linguist for the past fifteen years, Alex first appeared as a German in **Cabaret** and recently as a Frenchman in **The Boy Friend**. In his first panto for nine years, this time he is relieved not to be appearing as a foreigner (from this planet at least!).

MEGAN HARRIES-REES (Gretel)

Megan is 11 years of age and has been in the Mitre Players all of her life. She has appeared in many productions such as **The Sound of Music** and **Merrily We Roll Along.** She has also been in quite a few pantomimes.

MARY HOLTON (Puss in Boots) Mary has been in the Mitre Players since the original Way Out West. Her favourite role to date has been Mustard Seed in A Midsummer Night's Dream at the Globe theatre. A trusted and gifted painter, she has been allowed to paint most of the black on the set.

Bug) This is Warwick's first panto for 10 years. Like pantomime itself, he has not altered over those years; this is another way of saying he has still not learned either to sing or dance.


FRASER MACDONALD (Doctor Watt)

NATASSJA WILLIAMS (Tinkerbelle)


